Service Canada provides Canadian seniors with a single point of access to a wide range of government services and benefits.

The Canada Pension Plan (CPP)

CPP provides contributors and their families with partial replacement of earnings in the case of retirement, disability or death.

Survivor's Pension

CPP survivor's pension is paid to the person who, at the time of death, is the legal spouse or common-law partner of the deceased contributor.

Old Age Security (OAS)

The OAS pension is a monthly payment available to seniors aged 65 and older who meet the Canadian legal status and residence requirements.

The Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)

GIS provides a monthly non-taxable benefit to OAS pension recipients who have a low income and are living in Canada.

If you stopped working or received lower earnings to raise your children, you may be able to use the CPP's "child-rearing provisions" to increase the value of your CPP benefits.
